

Ground Rules for all participants in TusCon Gaming, Including: TusLAN Computer Gaming Table Top Gaming and LARP Areas

- **No one will be allowed to play without signing a liability waiver.** While we'll take reasonable precautions to make sure this is a safe gaming area, you are ultimately responsible for everything that happens to you or your equipment, possession's, Etc. while you are here. You must acknowledge that legally before you can set up to play any games.
- **No one under the age of 18 will be admitted without a signed permission slip.** We're sorry, but there are legal issues with minors and we have to ensure that the parents are aware of all potential hazards while in this area.
- **The LAN party hosts, Table Top Gaming staff and LARP Staff have final say about everything that happens in the Gaming Area's.** We can, and will, remove jerks to make things more enjoyable for everyone else. Hopefully, you're not a jerk; if you aren't, you're going to have a great time today.
- **No smoking.** It's unhealthy, and it irritates many of our players. If you want to smoke, take it outside.
- **No drinking.** We have a firm no-alcohol policy, as we believe you can have more fun without booze than you can with it. Anyone caught drunk on the premises will be kicked out.
- **No drugs or alcohol are allowed in the game room.** Anything you choose to do off-site is your business (and your responsibility), but no drugs or alcohol are allowed on-site.

- **No horseplay, no running around, no throwing things.** This computer gaming area is filled with thousands of dollars of fragile equipment, and the other gaming areas have expensive gaming materials, and you can damage something very easily. Therefore, no wrestling matches, no affectionate tussles, no tossing disks or foosballs around. Obviously, violence of any sort will lead to instant ejection and a permanent ban.
- **Keep the noise level to a minimum.** Occasional shouts of glee are fine when you cap someone, but repeatedly shouting how great you are will not be tolerated. Keep it down. As we all are sharing space with others, the hosts and staff running the gaming room do not want to have to talk over you, so please be considerate of others while in the game room.
- **No insults.** Good-natured ribbing is fine, but the moment someone gets upset, you stop *immediately*. Repeated violators will be ejected.
- **Please watch your language!** We will have minors present, so please keep your language at PG-13 or lower. If you must make a loud expletive, please use a bleep word such as my favorite, "**Euphemism!**". The adults around you will know what you mean. Occasional muttered profanity is fine, but loud profanity will get you a warning. Repeated warnings will get you ejected from the event.
- **Do not touch other people's stuff without permission.** The difference between "borrowing" and "theft" can become very difficult to prove, and we don't intend to try. Also, you might break something.
- **No stealing.** If you are caught, we will not only ensure that your weaselly little butt never plays a game in this town again, but we will call the police to ensure that charges are pressed against you.
- **No cheating.** This includes bots, hacks, or anything else that isn't strictly aboveboard. Remember, this gaming room is not the American justice system; it is an enlightened tyranny. If we think that whatever you're doing is sufficiently shady, you will get booted.
- **No inappropriate material.** No pornography or any other offensive images should be on anyone's screens at this event. That includes screensavers and backgrounds. Minors will be present, and showing minors pornographic images is illegal. We do not want to see anyone taken to jail!
- **No trading of copyrighted material.** Anyone caught exchanging or downloading warez, MP3s by RIAA-backed musicians, or any other copyrighted files will be booted. We don't need the hassle of getting sued. This includes unauthorized RPG PDF files as well.

- **Help us keep the game rooms clean.** Please leave the gaming area as clean as you found it by throwing all of your trash in the trash bins, thank you very much!
- **Outside food and drink are not permitted.** Only food and drink that are purchased or provided on the premises may be consumed here.
- **You may be ejected from the Game Room for breaking any of these rules or at the discretion of the LAN party hosts, and/or the Table Top Gaming and LARP Staff.** You are not entitled to a refund if you are ejected for any reason.
- **Have fun!** We're sorry to have to start out with such an ominous set of rules, but it's necessary to ensure that the event runs smoothly. The whole point of these rules is to make sure that everyone has the best time that they possibly can - *so get out there and start fraggin'!*

Additional Ground Rules for BYOC* Participants in TusLAN at TusCon

*BYOC = Bring Your Own Computer

- **You are responsible for running current virus scans on your computer before you place your computer on our network.**
- **By paying a BYOC discount membership rate, you agree to bring a computer for use in TusLAN gaming.** If you do not bring a computer, you agree to buy a TusCon membership at the full rate before participating in any other TusCon activities.
- **Plug in only where you are told.** Doing otherwise may lead to power outages. In particular, do not plug into someone else's power strip. If you are not sure where to plug in, ask a staff member.
- **Keep your station area clean.** You are responsible for leaving your area as clean as you found it. If your area accumulates too much trash during the day, we may ask you to clean it up immediately; please do not give us flak about this.
- **You are responsible for having all appropriate hardware and software.** You are expected to bring a working computer with a network card and legal copies of all relevant game software and latest patches already installed. Please do not bring a broken computer and ask us to fix it. Please do not ask us to wait for 20 minutes while you install the game and all the latest patches.
- **BYOC hardware requirements:**
 - A computer with appropriate hardware (especially an Ethernet **NIC** for **GigabitEthernet** or at least **100Base-T**) and software (especially **TCP/IP**).
 - Monitor, keyboard, mouse and mouse pad
 - A power strip with surge protection might be helpful
 - Bringing your own CAT5e Ethernet patch cord might be helpful.
- **No speakers.** Speakers create an incredible racket and drain excessive power. **Headphones only, please.** We will have a few headphones to loan out, but please try to bring your own.
